

The Friends of Bishop's House were started in 1992 to provide extra amenities for the House and to provide a bursary fund for those recommended by their clergy as being in need of help to be able to come to Iona. Over the years many have been helped and the Friends have provided many items and improvements to the House.

The individual membership fee is £15 per year, £25 for couples; a single life membership is £200. Many Friends also try to raise further money by some fundraising of their own during the year.

The Friends have a voluntary Secretary and Treasurer and the President is the Bishop of Argyll and the Isles.

In 1894 when Alexander Chinnery-Haldane, the Bishop of Argyll and the Isles, founded Bishop's House he saw Iona as a home of prayer: the powerhouse from which the light of the Gospel, its search and healing words, had spread across the world. Thus Bishop's House became a house of prayer, study, contemplation and Eucharist.
